

PLANNING BOARD MINUTES

November 9, 2009

Present: John Carpenter, David Landry, Steve Tasse, Heidi Behling, Jen Corrigan, Ann Leger, Jo Carpenter – recording secretary

Chairperson John Carpenter opened the meeting at 7:03 PM.

Approval of Minutes

David Landry made a motion to accept the minutes as written. This motion was seconded by Heidi Behling and passed unanimously.

Correspondence

There was no correspondence to be reviewed by the Board.

Budget

The Board discussed what they need for a budget for 2010. The Board noted that they are substantially under budget at this time but with their on going work on the Master Plan they decided to that they should ask for \$3,000 again this year and not ask for money specifically for the Master Plan.

David Landry made a motion to request \$3,000 for the 2010 Planning Board budget which is the same amount requested in 2009. This motion was seconded by Steve Tasse and passed unanimously.

Master Plan

The Board reviewed the spreadsheet that John Carpenter had developed from the data collated by Jen Corrigan. John noted that he has a little more work to do on one chart. The Board agreed that these spreadsheets will help with data presentations. Jen Corrigan suggested that pictures of the scenic vistas that people said they would like to see protected be included when that information is presented. The Board thought that this would definitely add to the presentation.

John had also developed a short Power Point presentation for the first Master Plan meeting. The Board was happy with the presentation. Jen will help john with some additions.

The first Master Plan public meeting was scheduled for December 3, 2009 at 7:00 PM. This meeting will focus on the results of the General Issues question and the draft vision statement. Jo will take care of postings and putting an ad in the paper.

Maps for use at the various meetings were discussed. The map done by Dave Carlisle for the Conservation Commission will be used as well as the Shelburne Zoning Map, a large map with all the roads on it, a slope map, a map which shows flood plain and a vegetation map. John will take them to York Land Services to see if they can scan them and print copies.
