

## HERE'S WHAT THE SHELBURNE TRANSFER STATION NEEDS FROM YOU

Shelburne's "dump" is **not allowed to handle hazardous material**  
Remember – **You must separate your trash. It's the law in Shelburne**

**ALUMINUM CANS** – Aluminum beverage cans only. Cat food, foil, etc. Not allowed

**PLASTIC BEVERAGE CONTAINERS** – PETE plastic bottles. Remove caps

**TIN CANS** – Any can that does not go in aluminum beverage bin goes here. Please rinse them out. Labels OK

**PLASTIC MILK JUGS --jugs** – Regular milk jugs, water, and juice containers (HDPE) Remove caps and rinse. Labels OK. Oil cans, detergent bottles, white milk jugs not allowed.

**DETERGENT BOTTLES** – Laundry products, white milk jugs. Caps off and rinse. **No Misc. plastic articles**  
**ALL OTHER PLASTIC CONTAINERS GO INTO TRUCK**

**GLASS** – All glass, any color – **Except fluorescent lights** – goes into the glass barrel. Empty and rinse.  
Fluorescent lights handle separately. **See attendant**

**METALS** – Small metal waste (Coat hangers, bolts, nails) Large metal items go on "Metal" pile

**CARDBOARD** – Corrugated boxes, empty and dry. Please flatten.

**PAPER** – Needs to be dry. In the bins provided.

**PAINT CANS** – Paint cans are considered **Hazardous waste if there is liquid paint in them.** We can only accept them if they are **empty or dry.** Cover off.

**WASTE OIL** – Goes in the drum inside the building

**VEHICLE BATTERIES** – Go on the pallet inside

**TIRES** – On pile outside

**BRUSH AND YARD WASTE** – On the piles in the yard (Clean wood – 5 in. diameter max.) **Note: Yard wastes do not go onto garbage truck.**

**CONSTRUCTION / DEMOLITION DEBRIS** – Painted wood or treated wood, sheet rock, furniture, etc. **See the attendant.**

**SHINGLES** – Shingles must be uncontaminated with other waste. **See the attendant**

**APPLIANCES** – Sinks stoves, refrigerator, freezers, etc. **See the attendant.**

**LARGE METAL WASTE** – **See the attendant.**

**TREE STUMPS** – Not allowed under our permit.

**WASTE CONTAINING MERCURY** – **See the attendant**

**TELEVISIONS / COMPUTERS** – **See the attendant**

**MISCELLANEOUS WASTES** – Bulky plastic items, stuffed furniture, etc. **See the attendant.**

**NOTE: SHEET MATERIAL (TARPS, PLASTIC SHEETS, RUGS, ETC.) MUST BE CUT INTO 4 FT. BY 4 FT. SECTIONS HOSES OR ROPES MUST BE CUT INTO 4 FT. LENGTHS** (Per order of Mt. Carberry Landfill)
